

AGE 65 AND OVER AS PERCENTAGE OF TOTAL POPULATION

(label in each county shows number of people age 65 and over)









LATINOS AS PERCENTAGE OF TOTAL AGE 65 AND OVER

(label in each county shows number of Latinos age 65 and over)




Latinos as Percentage of Total Age 65 and Over




ASIANS AS PERCENTAGE OF TOTAL AGE 65 AND OVER

(label in each county shows number of Asians age 65 and over)





Asians as Percentage of Total Age 65 and Over



AFRICAN AMERICANS AS PERCENTAGE OF TOTAL AGE 65 AND OVER



(label in each county shows number of White Non-Latinos age 65 and over)






