Health disparities between elders of color and non-Hispanic whites are well documented and their elimination continues to be a public health and public priority. Promoting state of the art research in reducing these disparities is the goal of the **Resource Centers for Minority Aging Research (RCMAR)** network, a NIA-funded, Center-coordinated program that provides mentoring and career support for junior faculty (RCMAR Scholars) engaged in minority aging research.

This [special APHA session](#) highlights recent research from selected RCMAR Scholars that is pushing the field forward. Topics include addressing barriers to HIV testing among older minority adults, dietary patterns and cancer mortality among older Blacks and Whites, and using mindfulness techniques to address incarceration-related stress among African American adults.

Why do different health surveys report differing rates of uninsurance? In this special APHA session, sponsored by Applied Public Health Statistics, leading researchers and health policy experts discuss the methodological challenges of collecting coverage data in state and federal surveys. Organized by Center Associate Director Ninez Ponce and moderated by Center Director Gerald Kominski, the session features experts from CHIS, the National Center for Health Statistics, State Health Access Data Assistance Center (SHADAC), and the UCLA Center for Health Policy Research on topics ranging from how questions on insurance status are worded in health surveys to nonresponse bias to the impact of the ACA on uninsurance rates.
