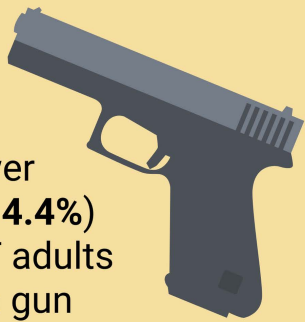

Gun Ownership and Fear of Gun Violence Among California LGBT Adults

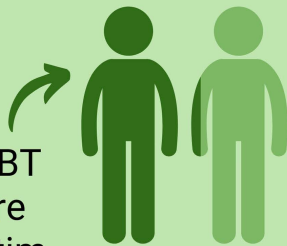
Somewhat fewer LGBT adults (**14.4%**) than non-LGBT adults (**18.0%**) have a gun in the household

2



Among people who had a gun in the household, similar proportions of LGBT adults (**7.6%**) and non-LGBT (**7.9%**) adults reported that a gun in their household is unlocked and loaded

A bigger proportion of LGBT adults (**54.6%**) say they are worried about being a victim of gun violence than their non-LGBT (**44.5%**) counterparts

Younger LGBT adults ages 18–24 (**60.1%**) feared gun violence more than any other age group

Among LGBT adults, more people of color are worried about gun victimization than their white, non-Hispanic peers
