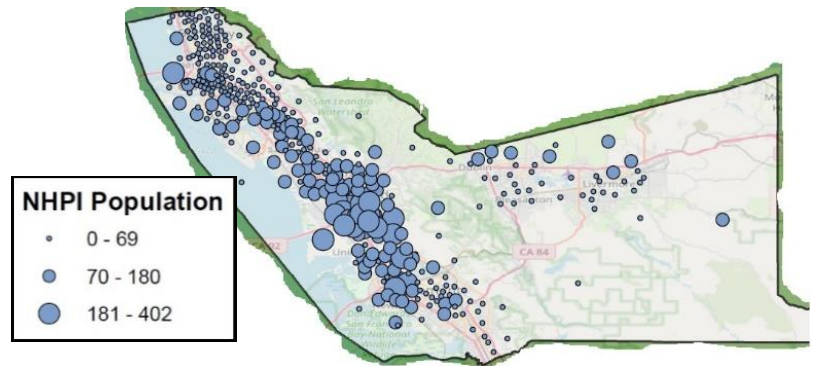

NHPIs lived in Alameda County in 2020.¹



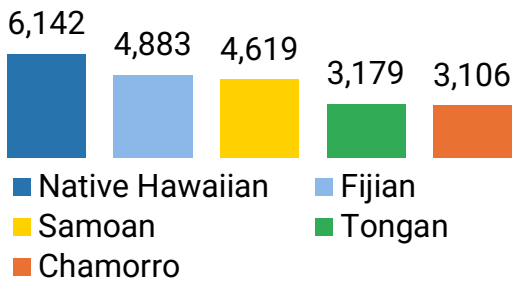

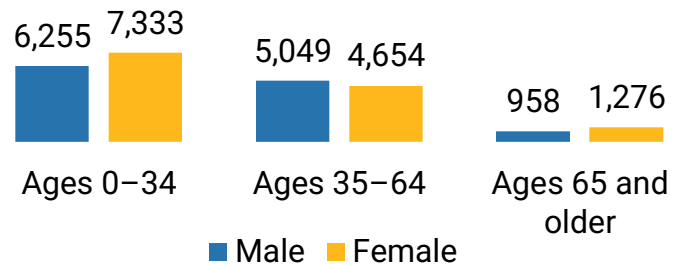
Native Hawaiians make up the **largest subgroup** followed by Fijians and Samoans.²

Few NHPIs are ages 65 and older. The largest age group, **0–34 years**, has **more females than males**.⁴

Number of NHPIs by Subgroups²



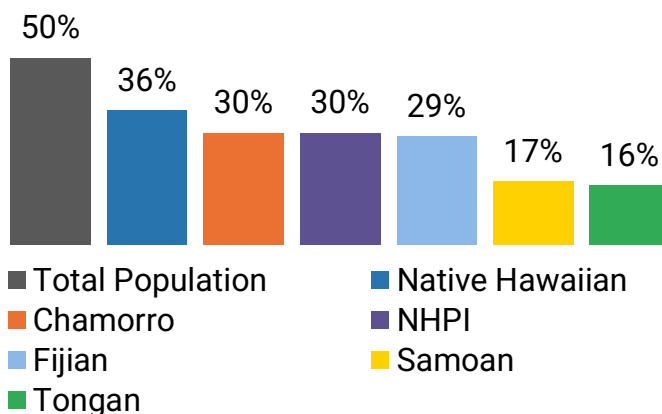
Number of NHPIs by Age and Sex⁴



Education



Percentage of NHPIs with a Bachelor's Degree or Higher⁵



Among NHPIs ages 25 and older, a **higher percentage of Native Hawaiians** have a **bachelor's degree or higher** compared to other NHPI subgroups.⁵

Among residents ages 25 and older, **NHPIs** have the **lowest bachelor's degree or higher attainment** at 30%, compared to 60% for white residents and 50% of the total population.⁵

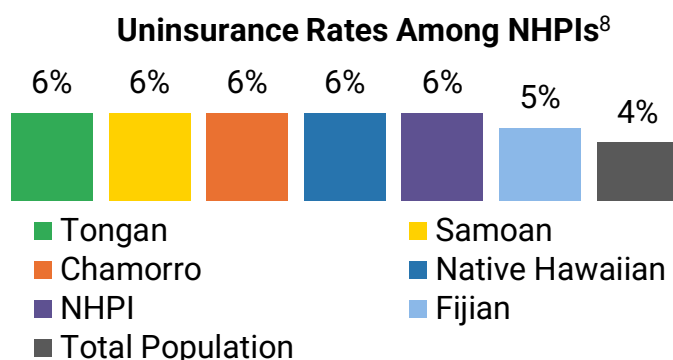
Health



Among NHPIs:

- 32% of NHPI adults have ever been **tested for HIV**.⁶
- 46% of NHPI adults **visited a dental clinic in the past six months**.⁷

NHPI subgroups have similar uninsurance rates.⁸



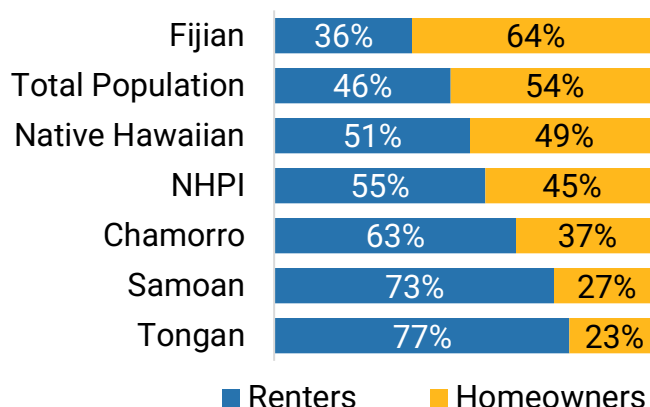
Housing



Among NHPIs:

- 55% are renters** and **45% are homeowners**.⁹
- About **96% live in households with relatives**.¹⁰
- Significant disparities exist between NHPI homeownership rates by subgroup.¹¹

Income and Poverty

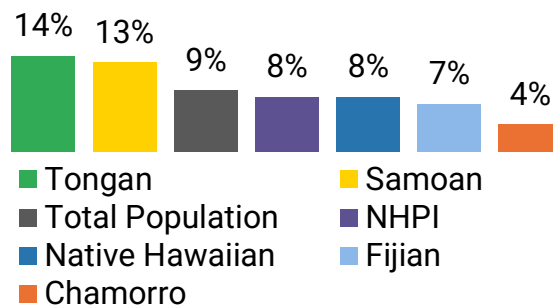


Among NHPIs:

- Per capita income (\$38,162)** is lower than other racial and ethnic groups except Hispanics or Latinos.¹²
- 8% live at or below the federal poverty level (FPL)**.¹²
- A lower percentage of **Fijians and Chamorros** live below the FPL compared to other NHPI subgroups.¹²

A higher percentage of Tongans live below the poverty line compared to other NHPI subgroups.¹²

Disability



NHPIs have a **higher percentage of people with disabilities** than the total population.¹³

- 37% of NHPIs ages 65 and older have a disability**, which is higher than the county's share of 30%.¹³

Notes:

- For consistency in data representation, the NHPI Data Policy Lab has utilized the U.S. Census designation “Chamorro” in this fact sheet, rather than the community-preferred spelling “CHamoru.”
- Census figures utilize combined single and multiracial race categories except for white, which utilizes single race, non-Hispanic. Hispanic is defined as Hispanic or Latino (of any race).
